Ho and Munda Uprisings	<p>Date: 1820, 1827, 1899, 1900, 1860-1920</p> <p>People associated with revolt : Raja Parhat</p> <p>Nature & Objective: Against British rulers, local money-lenders and Zamindars.</p>
Kol Uprisings	<p>Date: 1831-32</p> <p>People associated : Budhu Bhagat, Vinda Rai and Sarga Munda</p> <p>Nature & Objective: Against expansion of British rule on Kol land and transfer of their land to outsiders like Sikh and Muslim farmers.</p>
Bhumij Revolt	<p>Date: 1832-1833</p> <p>People associated : Ganga Narayan</p> <p>Nature & Objective: Against land revenue policy of Britishers.</p>
Santhal Uprising	<p>Date: 1855-56</p> <p>People associated : Sidhu, Kanhu, Bhairo & Chand</p> <p>Nature & Objective: Against the exploitative Zamindars and moneylenders.</p>
Sapha Hor Revolt	<p>Date: 1870</p> <p>People associated : Baba Bhagirath Manjhi, Lal Hembram & Paica Murmu</p> <p>Nature & Objective : Against restriction on religious sentiment</p>
Munda Revolt	<p>Date: 1899-1900</p> <p>People associated : Birsa Munda</p> <p>Nature & Objective : Against alienation of tribal land due to Forest Regulation Act of 1865</p>
Tana Bhagat Movement	<p>Date: 1914</p> <p>People associated : Oraon started the movement and Jatra Bhagat was the main leader</p> <p>Nature & Objective: Against moneylenders and contractors.</p>
